- › How much will you trust for Cloud Provider
 - Security; Legislative; Access; Sanitization

› Cost of getting your Petabytes back

- > Upload 1PB costs zero
- Store 1PB for a month 140k\$
- › Fetch 1PB once 150k\$ Ten people read it: 1.5M
- > 1PB over 100G theoretically more than 1 day

› Performance Issue

> My data is 10,000Km from my supercomputer


