# HR telco history & CARNet


- 90's
  - 1991 project CARNet
  - Telecommunication monopoly (HPT): CARNet (first dark fiber links)
  - Network Access for end-users (dial-in modem pools)
- 00's
  - Telecommunication liberalisation: newcomers in fixed and mobile
  - Network Access for individuals (ISDN, xDSL, Cable, HSDP, UMTS, 802.11 at institutional level)
- 10's
  - FTTH, still waiting for regulation
  - LTE (fourth generation) trials

# Mobile telco market @ HR

- Croatian mobile telephony market was liberalized in 1998
- The first private mobile network operator entered the market in July 1999
- From October 2005, there are 3 mobile network operators operating commercially
- The first mobile network service was provided in 1990 through the analogue NMT 450 network, which was switched off at the end of 2005.
- Mobile telecommunications services through GSM network (second generation), and through UMTS technology (third generation) since January 2005.
- Mobile Internet access through HSDPA technology was commercially offered in April 2006.
- First LTE (fourth generation) trials, Oct 2011


# HR Broadband penetration (1)



# Mobile networks – Market Shares












