

Pay or Stay!

- The majority of internet business models falls in two categories:
- Commercials (Stay):
 - Searches, maps, webmail, forums, social network
 - Google, Facebook, Yahoo
- Subscriptions (Pay):
 - Games
 - (too some extend also Facebook)
 - Exclusive content

Federated Social Network ?

- The driving business model for Social Networks is BBS based
- No commercial incentive to federate social networks
- If you have enough users (like FB/G+) this business model is perfect
- So no federated Social Network in the horizon...
- Enabling technology needed!

Innovation !

- Untie the social network / group ware from the private user database
- Converge messaging technologies
- Facilitate privacy and confidentiality

Email...

- Social Networks already use Email for:
 - Authentication
 - Notification
 - Content (webmail)
 - Federation

Scenarios

- Signup/Authentication:
 - Supply email
 - Choose username
 - Choose pasword

Confirm email

Scenarios

- Notification (e.g. home banking):
 - Email that you got a message...
 - Login to bank site
 - Read message

Scenarios

- Federation
 - Inviting new users
 - Breaking off internal communication to include others (e.g. in company private msg system).

Ideas

- New technology:
 - Google Wave
- Using and improving existing technologies:
 - Friendship database: GPG key servers (+3mio users)
 - Perfect for federated authentication
 - Enables secure communication
 - Improved user experience for keys needed!
 - Microblogging and status updates
 - Email! support in email clients needed

Ideas

- And while we are at it:
 - We also use social media to share photos and other assets.
 - So this little problem would also be nice to solve...
