- EU Research and Innovation Program
 - 7 years – 2014-2020
 - ~80 b€ (100 bSEK/year)
- Follows previous Framework Programs
 - Framework Program 7 (FP-7), FP-6, etc.
- Funds a large number of initiatives
 - All science areas
 - Infrastructure for science
 - Flagship projects
 - Public-Private partnership – support for European industry
- The home of GÉANT
 - + EC Future Internet program
 - + many “smaller” calls relevant for Nordic NRENs

Industrial Leadership

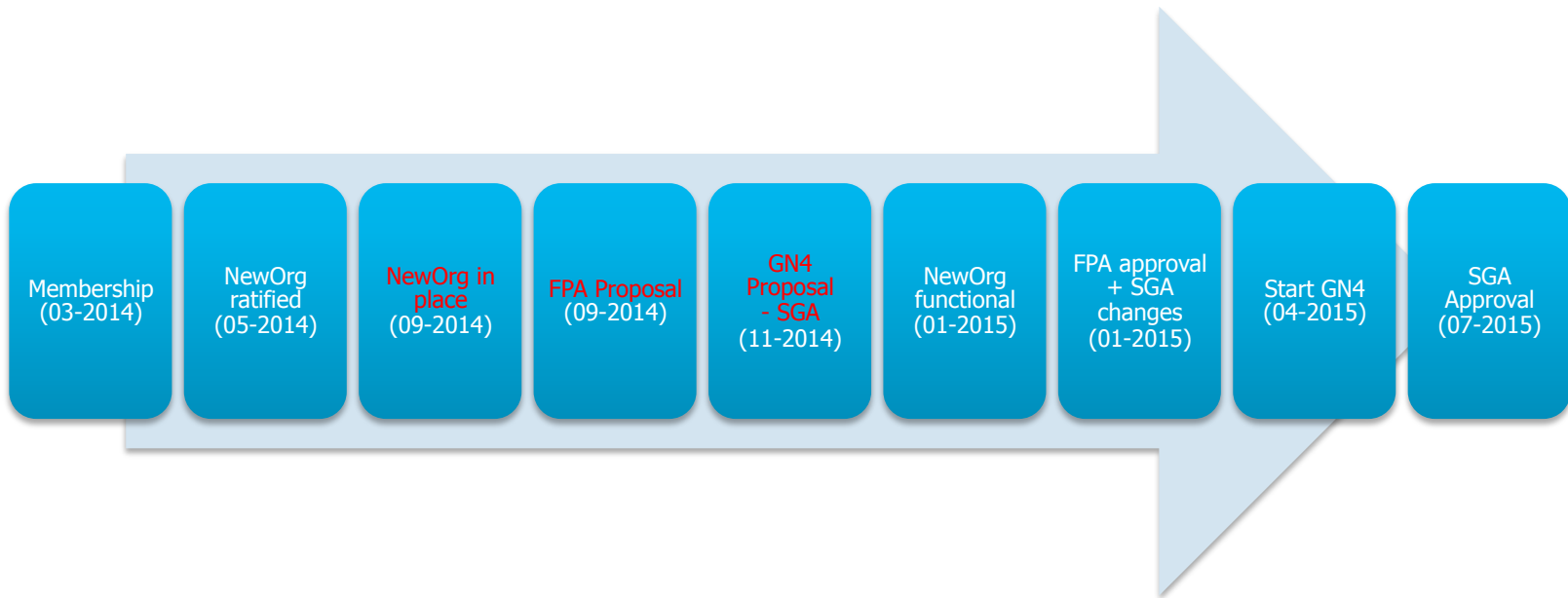
- **Leadership in Enabling and Industrial Technologies (LEIT)**

- 7 Year Program for GÉANT
 - Aligned with Horizon 2020
 - Aligned with "GÉANT Expert Group" report
 - Funding available in phases – 1+3+3 years
- Framework Partnership Agreement (FPA)
 - Strategic agreement between NRENs and EC
 - Covers 7 year period
 - Based on "GÉANT Strategy" and high-level objectives
 - Basis for agreeing (and funding) specific work programs
- A new way of organizing GÉANT
 - Ask for more strategic focus and alignment of NRENs
 - Driver for the merger

GÉANT Merger timeline

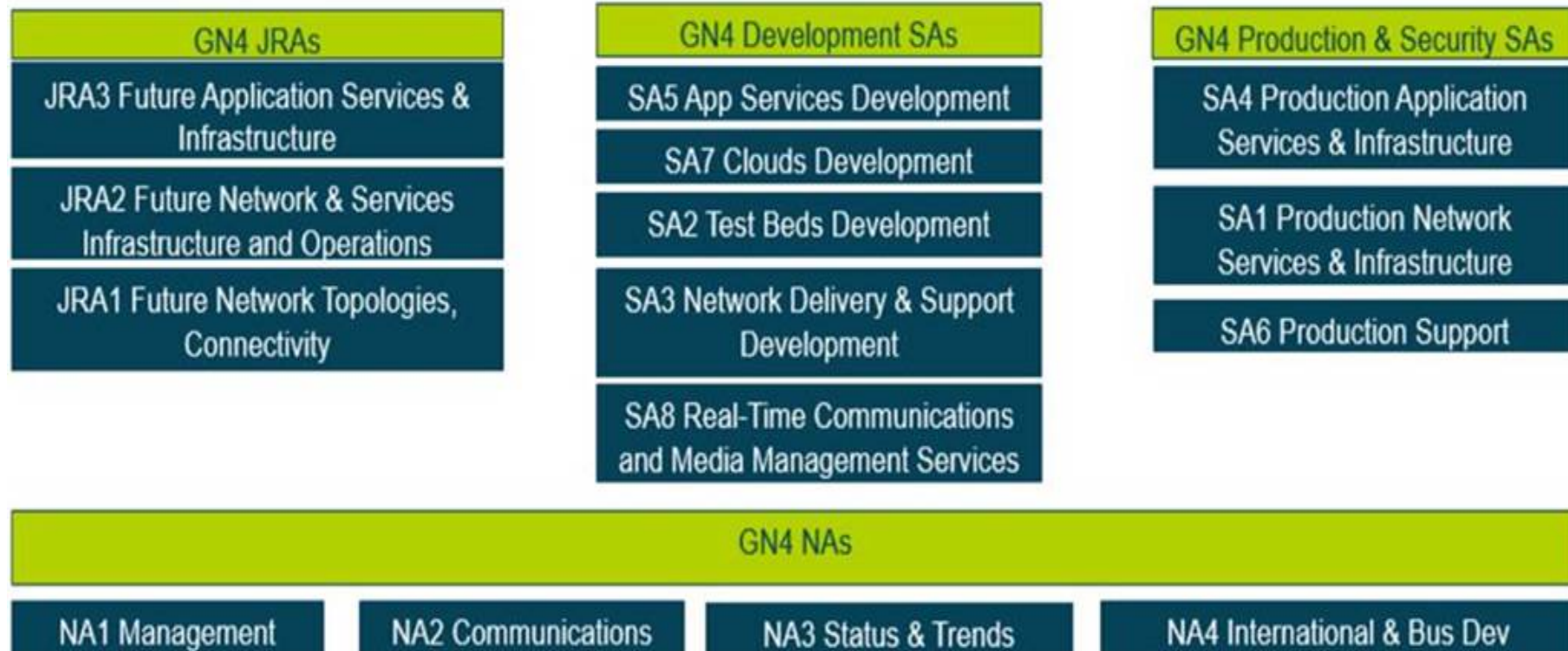


- Formed by the NREN PC
 - Oversee process of responding to EC H2020 call(s) for GÉANT
 - Proposals for FPA, work programs, ...
 - Members: GN3+ Exec, SIC chair, DANTE + TERENA management
- GÉANT Strategy & Innovation Committee (SIC)
 - Output: GÉANT strategy, basis for FPA
 - Chair: Erik Huizer, SURFnet
 - Nordic member: Martin Bech, DeIC
 - Report delivered summer 2014

- Strategic objectives and vision
- Implies no commitment for EC funding
 - No specific promises
 - No specific deliveries
- Headlines
 - A: Drive the Evolution of the Network
 - B: Support the Knowledge Community
 - C: Provide Security, Trust and Identity
 - D: Deliver Collaborative Ecosystem
 - E: Develop Human Capital
 - F: Enable GÉANT's Ongoing Development
- Submitted on 2 September 2014

- Specific Grant Agreement (SGA)
 - Contract for work under an FPA
 - One FPA can have many SGA's, in series and/or in parallel
- First call: SGA proposal GN4 Y1
 - April 2015 – March 2016
 - A single description of work, as GN3
 - Deadline: November 2014
- Expectation
 - 2 x 3-year calls: 2016-2018, 2018-2020
 - May be a single DoW, or multiple, parallel DoW's – not decided yet.

- New project, but just one year
 - Will in practice be extension of GN3+
 - Splits Service Activities (SAs) into "Development" and "Operation"
 - Introduces "Media" SA
- Draft Description of Work
 - Prepared by existing GN3+ activity leaders
 - NREN input via Call for Ideas phase
- Staffing
 - Activity Leaders: The Usual Suspects
 - Task Leaders: call just completed
 - Task members: call out ultimo September
- Work in progress
 - Finish Description of Work
 - Fix activity and task budgets
 - Staffing



- Useful first step to a better structure
- More work needed (GN4 Y2+)
- Could be split into several projects

- GN4 Year 2 starts April 2016
 - ... which means we're already late
 - If we want more than just "business as usual", we need to start now

 - Reduce cost, be more agile
 - Better fit with big picture of new GÉANT organization
 - Better workplan preparation method
